I’m excited to keep building programs that help families save, access fair credit, and feel confident about their financial future.

“Beyer joined Excite Credit Union in 2021 as Community Relations Manager and has since advanced to Vice President of Community Development. She serves on the board of the Latina Coalition of Silicon Valley and previously served with the Center for Excellence in Nonprofits and the Latino Community Foundation. She also volunteered as a Court-Appointed Special Advocate with Child Advocates of Silicon Valley, reflecting her long-standing commitment to service.
